Queensland Attorney-General and Minister for Industrial Relations Cameron Dick met 40 clients of not-for-profit organisation Westside Community Care at Acacia Ridge, last Friday.

Westside Community Care's head office is at Acacia Ridge but also operates from Oxley.

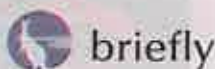
The organisation provides programs to help clients
